## How to Use

The John 3:16 FlipAbout is extremely **easy to use**. Just spend **2 minutes** getting yourself familiar and you'll be ready to go!

### Getting Familiar

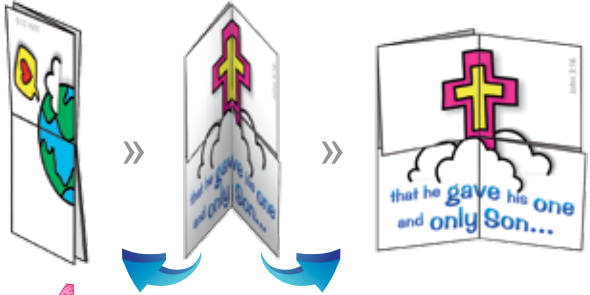
**1** With the FlipAbout facing you, **fold it horizontally**, with the top and bottom edges moving away from you.



**2** Turn the FlipAbout 90 degrees **counterclockwise**.



**3** **Open** the FlipAbout as you would open a book.



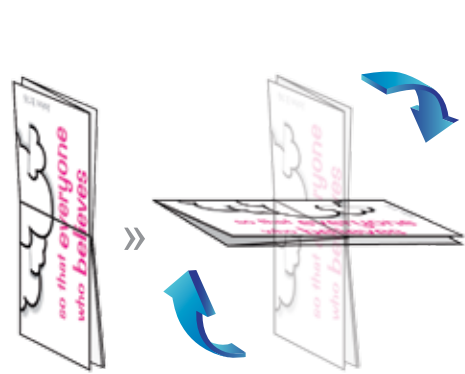
**4** Repeat steps 1 to 3 to reveal the other panels.



**5** This will bring you to the 4th panel. To return to the 3rd panel, **close** the FlipAbout as you would close a book.



**6** Turn the FlipAbout 90 degrees **clockwise**.



**7** **Open** the FlipAbout from the back.



### Using the John 3:16 FlipAbout

- > Start by **quickly flipping through the John 3:16 FlipAbout to catch the child's attention**. Children will often be intrigued as the FlipAbout's folding mechanism reveals 4 different pictures.
- > **Return to the 1st panel** to begin sharing the message of salvation.
- > **Reveal the remaining panels** as your presentation proceeds.
- > Guidelines on **what to say** can be found on the back.

# What to Say

First explain to the child that **John 3:16** is a verse from the Bible, God's special book for us.

Read the portion of the verse with each panel and use the following points to elaborate on key phrases.

You may need to tailor your gospel presentation to suit the age of your audience.

Use **Questions** to engage your listener and to check understanding.

Use **Bible verses** where appropriate, but be careful not to overload your listener with too many verses.



- 1) God made the world and everything in it.**
  - He created the sun, moon, stars and the earth
  - He created the land, sea, plants and animals
- 2) The most special thing he created was you and me.**
- 3) God loves us very much.**

Do you know who God is?

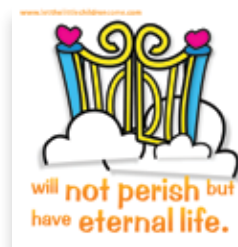
What is your favorite animal?

What are some other things that God created?

*Gen 1:1*  
In the beginning God created the sky and the earth.

*Gen 1:25*  
So God made the wild animals, the tame animals, and all the small crawling animals.

*Gen 1:27*  
So God created human beings in his image. In the image of God he created them. He created them male and female.



- 1) God doesn't want any of us to perish. He wants us to be with him in heaven forever.**
- 2) Heaven is a wonderful place.**
  - There is no sickness, no pain and no hunger
  - Everyone is perfectly happy

What do you think heaven is like?

Do you want to be with God in heaven?

*Rev 21:4*  
He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death, sadness, crying, or pain.

*Rom 3:23*  
Everyone has sinned and fallen short of God's glorious standard.

*Rom 6:23*  
The payment for sin is death. But God gives us the free gift of life forever in Christ Jesus our Lord.

*1 Cor 15:3*  
Christ died for our sins.

- 3) But because of the wrong things we have done, we can't be with God in heaven.**
  - We have all done things that have made God unhappy
  - These things are called sins
  - Telling lies, disobeying your parents, hurting others and being selfish are examples of sins
- 4) The punishment for our sins is that we can't be with God in heaven.**
- 5) That's why God gave us his son, Jesus.**
  - Instead of us being punished, Jesus took our place
  - Jesus died on the cross so that all the wrong things that we have done can be forgiven

Return to the Previous Panel



- 1) God loves us so much that he gave us a very special gift — his son, Jesus.**
- 2) Jesus was born on Christmas Day more than 2000 years ago.**
  - He ate, drank and slept like any other man on earth

Do you know when Jesus was born?

What do you think are some of the other things Jesus did while on earth?

What were some of the things you may have done that were wrong?

Do you know of any other wonderful things that Jesus did?

*Acts 13:30, 31*  
But God raised him up from the dead! After this, for many days, those who had gone with Jesus from Galilee to Jerusalem saw him.

*Rev 1:18*  
I am the One who lives; I was dead, but look, I am alive forever and ever!



- 1) God loves every single one of us and wants us all to be with him.**
- 2) If we want to be with God, we must first believe.**

Do you think you have sinned?

Do you want to ask God to forgive you?

Do you believe that Jesus died on the cross to take our punishment?

Do you want to invite Jesus into your life?

*1 John 1:9*  
But if we confess our sins, he will forgive our sins, because we can trust God to do what is right. He will cleanse us from all the wrongs we have done.

- 3) Believing in Jesus means:**
  - Believing that Jesus is God's son
  - Admitting that we have sinned and asking God to forgive us
  - Believing that Jesus died on the cross to be punished instead of us
  - Inviting Jesus into our lives to help us turn away from sin

- 4) We can now have a relationship with God.**
  - We can become children of God
  - We can call God our Father

- 5) We can one day be with God in heaven.**

- 6) Invite the child to sincerely pray for forgiveness and for Jesus to come into his/her life.**

- 7) Saying this prayer sincerely means:**

- You are truly sorry for all the wrong things you have done
- You truly believe that Jesus took the punishment for your sins
- You truly want to start a relationship with Jesus to help you turn from all the wrong things you have done and do what is right

Sample prayer:

“Dear Jesus, Thank you for loving me. I know that I have sinned. I have done things that are wrong. I believe that you died on the cross to pay the price for my sins. Please forgive all of my sins. Please come into my life and help me turn away from doing wrong. Thank you that because you paid the price for my sins, I can have a relationship with you and will one day be with you in heaven.”

- 3) But Jesus was special. He was God and never did anything wrong.**
  - He never disobeyed his parents, told a lie or hurt anyone
- 4) Jesus was God and did many wonderful things.**
  - He healed the sick
  - He walked on water
  - He raised the dead
- 5) The most wonderful thing Jesus did was when he died and became alive again.**
  - Jesus died on the cross
  - But on the third day, he returned to life



- 1) Jesus died and returned to life for every one of us.**
  - This includes you and me
